

# Affordable housing to be showcased

Sites in Parsippany, Morristown, Morris Twp. will be featured

The Housing Alliance of Morris County, a community collaboration of United Way of Morris County, will host its third annual Morris County Affordable Housing Showcase Bus Tour from 8:30 a.m. to noon on June 17.

The tour will begin at the New Jersey Foundation for the Blind, located at 230 Diamond Spring Road, Denville, and will visit five affordable-housing sites.

"Our annual bus tour gives public officials a firsthand look at how partnerships between nonprofit developers and municipalities can create innovative affordable-housing opportunities," said Michelle Roers DiNapoli, Housing Alliance co-chairwoman and director of community impact at United Way of Morris County.
