


90% of participants earn their NJ high school diploma.

ABOUT NEWBRIDGE JOBS PLUS

NewBridge Jobs Plus is an education, jobs and counseling service with an impressive track record for helping young adults turn their lives around. Students learn at their own pace. They receive academic assistance, life and professional skills training, career and college coaching, and counseling to overcome emotional challenges.

The program is **FREE** to area residents **AGES 16-24** who leave traditional high school without a diploma. NewBridge Jobs Plus prepares young adults to earn their New Jersey high school diplomas and pursue successful futures. Graduates develop confidence, responsibility, and self-advocacy.

HISTORY

Created in 1983, NewBridge Jobs Plus is the longest-running program of its kind in Morris County. More than 1,000 young adults have been served. The program initially was called "Project 70001" and then "NewBridge 70001." The 70 in 70001 refers to the 1970 federal grant that inspired our program.



WHAT WE DO

NewBridge Jobs Plus runs Monday-Thursday, 5 hours per day. The program provides:

- HSE test preparation
- Career & college counseling
- Linkage to post-secondary training and financial support
- Individual supportive counseling
- Case management
- Employment skills training
- Support groups
- Work & volunteer experience
- Confidence building
- Life skills education
- Job search assistance
- Job shadowing
- Motor vehicle services coordination
- Food & transportation

NewBridge Jobs Plus holds an annual cap-and-gown ceremony in June for participants who have completed all the program requirements. Several graduates each year are awarded scholarships for ongoing education funded by NewBridge Services Board of Trustees and community partners.
